

Streetcar Camp

At the Minnesota Streetcar Museum's first-ever Streetcar Camp, children will explore our historic streetcars from top to bottom. Working with experienced Museum members, they'll see first-hand how streetcars operate. We'll examine air brakes to learn how air pressure is used to stop a twenty-ton trolley. We'll see how the controller regulates speed. We'll look at rail and track switches, electrical circuits, the overhead wire system, and more. And, at the end of the session, each child will have the unique opportunity to climb into the Motorman's chair and run the streetcar down the track. If your child loves streetcars, this will be a day they will never forget.

Drop off your child at the Linden Hills Station, 42nd and Queen Avenue South, by 9 AM Thursday morning. (If the weather presents a problem, you'll be contacted by phone and email.) Each child should bring a bag lunch with their name on it. Bottled water and a morning snack will be provided. Pick-up will be at the Station at 1 PM. That will also be a good time to take pictures.
